Thank you for completing the Microsoft Form confirming that your child will be attending Thurston this academic year.

Cost

The final price of the visit is £330 per child. A £60 deposit has already been scheduled for payment – please note this <u>must</u> be paid by **Thursday 29**th **February**. The remaining outstanding balance of £270 will be split into two instalments, one of £135 which is due by **Tuesday 30**th **April** and another of £135 which is due **by Friday 28**th **June**. You will receive a text message when the payments have been set up on SchoolMoney.

Medical Info

Benedict Biscop CE Academy use the personal consent and medical form required by Thurston. We will hand this out, along with a kit list, at the Thurston information session.

We are taking Calpol with us in case a child is unwell and we need your permission to administer this. Please complete the following Microsoft Form <u>Thurston Calpol Consent Form</u> to give permission.

If your child requires a travel sickness tablet please hand this to Mr Allison on the day of the trip in a named envelope, with a tablet for the return journey in a separate named envelope.

If you have indicated that your child uses an inhaler, they should show the first aider that they have one with them prior to leaving school. Without an inhaler they will be unable to participate in the visit.

All other prescribed medicines should be handed to Mr Allison - children should not carry any medication.
