#### Morning Drop-Off Facility – Keeping Our Children Safe

We operate a morning drop-off facility to help ease congestion in the streets around school and make the area safer for children and residents using the footpaths.



We kindly remind all parents/carers that the drop-off zone is for children to be

dropped off to access the KS2 gate. It should not be used for parking and walking younger children to EYFS, as this poses a safety risk to those walking through the car park and disrupts the flow of traffic for others.

Additionally, please ensure that cars do not 'tailgate' through



the gates. The drop-off area opens at 8:45 am, and access is permitted only when a member of staff is present at the KS2 gate.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe and efficient drop-off system for everyone.
