School Parking Leaflet - Sunderland Council

'Sunderland City Councils Road Safety Team would like to remind all parents/carers to please park safely, legally and considerately, this means even for a few minutes to drop off or pick up your child.

We are regularly liaising with the council's Parking Services team about when they can visit the road outside each school in the city, to help us keep the road clear.

A mobile enforcement vehicle is fitted with a CCTV camera which captures any vehicle that is parked illegally on School Keep Clears.'

As outlined in previous Newsletters, we operate a morning drop-off facility to help ease congestion in the streets around school and to make the area safer for children and residents using the footpaths. We kindly remind all parents/carers that the drop-off zone is for children to be dropped off to access the KS2 gate - it should not be used for parking and walking younger children to EYFS, as this poses a safety risk to those walking through the car park and disrupts the flow of traffic for others.

Additionally, please ensure that cars do not 'tailgate' through the gates - access is permitted only when a member of staff is present at the KS2 gate (opening at 8:45am) and as always, please park around school with consideration for our neighbours and do not block driveways/ pavements.
